I Gotta Love Who?

"I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, that you may be children of your Father in heaven" (Matthew 5:44, 45).

I imagine the disciples found this call to love your enemies as challenging. It is not our normal reaction to people who hurt or hate us. Our country and state politics are deeply divided. The tendency is to see the other side as political enemies. Sometimes churches get divided like that too, or even families. Can we love and pray for people with whom we have very real differences that pit us against one another? Jesus teaches us to love *all*.

David Livermore, an expert on cultural differences shares this story, "The other day I was working out at the gym and I overheard a guy say to his buddy, "So tomorrow I have to go to diversity training ... " "That's right up there with getting a root canal!" to which his friend responded, "I don't mind diverse people as long as they agree with me!" That's the real divide: views, values, and beliefs.


One of the growing challenges of being church together is the budding diversity of congregations. Even twenty to thirty years ago, such widespread diversity did not typically factor into being the church together. National politics has become a dividing wall that separates. How do we respond to these differences? There are more polarizing issues and politicians today. Can we talk politics and religion, or is that just causing division? Can we disagree without being disagreeable? Can we truly love one another regardless of our different views, values, and beliefs? Of course we can, and Jesus commands it. We just need to express ourselves with respect for the other. And we need to be accepting of our differences.

We can model what it looks like to love others even when we disagree. Remember, they are human beings made in God's image also. Maybe the

key is seeing each person as someone God deeply loves (loved enough to send his Son to die on the cross for). For us as Christians, that is the most important view, value, and belief. It means we need to love them even if they don't love us. Jesus did. That is what it means to be children of our Father in heaven.



Faith Lutheran Church Minutes— June 21, 2021

Housekeeping Item: Lori Krueger. She is not a member of our church but has been a very active member of the community and volunteer fire department, etc. She has recently had medical issues running into tremendous medical bills. This was brought before the Council -is it possible to give her any help? A discussion followed; there are some concerns of setting a precedent, especially since she is not church member, so it doesn't fall under expanded ministry. It was decided to forward the information to John (head of Endowment).

OLD BUSINESS: EID Grant, All money from this grant is spoken for and has been paid out.

NEW BUSINESS: Continuation following the end of Pastor Jim's contract. At some point; we'll need to consider this. He turns 70 next May; would like to cut back farther. We need to know something by November for Stephanie to do the budget. We will need to draw up an exit strategy even though he will not be abandoning us. First step is to find out how flexible will the synod be? Would synod allow going to 25%? He would be willing to mentor Kelly if possible. He will be talking to bishop within next month to month-and-a half. There should be a meeting with the Personnel Committee by October or November, as his birthday is May 15th. We will have to be thinking about what happens with next year's contract? Synod Letter: A letter received from the synod was brought up for thought. The letter had said to save the date; they are looking for 50 congregations for an Initiative. It is to help congregations to come up with new ideas, new plans with a committee of 5 people. This is a 2-year initiative. If we can do this it might be a good thing to help us at this point. They need a rostered leadership drawn up.

Stewardship – Stephanie Mittnacht: Looking only at sheet numbers, they can appear kind of funky because of paid out of grant money. That's the reason. Our loan will come due in February. Since we still have over \$100,000 in the checkbook, if we keep paying it down monthly, and the balance is low enough, we'll probably just pay it off. Will look at it again later in the year. Stewardship drive; will be more an inspirational than "desperational".

Lay Ministry – Joyce Sorenson: We went thru proper channels but still have that one piano left, and, due to some concerns that have been expressed, we will keep that one. It will be put in the music room; so old electronic piano is still with praise band. Praise band is nearing readiness to return.

Fellowship – Cheryl Domrath: They are again serving each week. A suggestion was made to make it part of youth service; one adult, 2 kids.

Property – Lyle Roehrig: Our church had inspection from insurance; 1 item was brought up to make to have discussed, brought back to the insurance company as Lyle needs to report result. We need to review our current volunteer and employee program for working with youth to make sure all is up-to-date with relevant policies and procedures, and classes concerning appropriate behavior, & background checks, etc. Cleaning our Welcome Sign; had to take sign off to replace; should we change what it says? Now says "All are Welcome". If you think of something talk to Lyle.

<u>Christian Education</u> – Anderia Frank: VBS is a grand success with over 80 kids attending.

Adjourn: Having completed all business, a motion was made and the meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer at 7:30 pm.
