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### An Invitation to Dream

By the time you receive this newsletter, I will have been pastor of Faith Lutheran Church for about 100 days. I had come in with the intention of at first really “listening” to you, “just shut up and listen.” And I have done my best at that. I know I have not heard from the shy ones, but I will keep trying. I will keep listening.

I feel like now it is time to begin to take the next step. The next step is a process of prayerfully considering: (1.) where Faith should be going, (2.) how to get there, and then (3) making an action plan, and (4.) following that action plan. The very first step now is dreaming. We all have to dream a little. Or dream big.

Goal setting is later, where you nail things down. Dreaming is something else. Dreaming is where you have a fragile idea or a vision and you tell your waking friends about it so they can begin to dream it too.

What do you dream for Faith Lutheran Church? What do we not have that we should have? What do we already have that we should have more of? One of the things about dreams is that they are hard to remember, hard to express; they fade away in the morning. But if we share them they can inspire us all.

One of the things I know is that the Holy Spirit likes to make us work together. One person will be inspired by the Spirit with half an idea and somebody else will be inspired with another half of the idea, but they both have to show up and share their piece for any of us to get the gift the Spirit sends. Like two puzzle pieces that reveals a bigger picture. The Spirit is an abundant gift-giver, so there are more pieces out there than merely two halves. Come and share what you have. Come and receive what others share.

If it makes more sense to you, don't think about it like a dream, but what is in your heart. What is your heart's desire for your beloved Faith Lutheran community? What have you always wished for, for Valders? What did the people who taught you to love Jesus teach you about our beloved community that we could benefit from recalling?

What do you think we have been preparing for a long time now, ripening, that we can now take the next step from? Where do you want to go next? What can we build from existing foundations? Where do we need to lay new foundations?

This is a time to dream big without worries about money, about what “we have tried before that did not work,” about people and resources. When we hear the right dream shared, it will be like the hand bell choir's sweetest bell has sounded. We will hear it (really hear it) and say “That's it!” And everything necessary will fall into place and it will happen.

When we share our vision for this community of faith, all the rest, the goal setting, the action plans, will be easy.

Today we start with prayer. Lent seems like the perfect time to journey together in a season of self-examination and meditation, a time for seeking God's guidance. Let us journey together.

## Faith Lutheran Church Minutes—January 16, 2023

**Pastor's Report:** He now has a list of members, active and inactive, and will call inactive members. He has seen almost all the shut-ins; will be receiving Bob and Kathy Mattern. He'll be having a scheduled breakfast with the area pastors. Officiated at the Evenson and Argall funerals. Has taught songs to kids. He presented us with some comments and ideas: The 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Amazing Grace is coming up; this could be a good Lenten theme. He has noticed things are not always up to date on bulletin our boards, and has asked that the various church boards attempt to keep things more timely. He is looking forward to VBS this summer. He mentioned he would love to hear our church stories. Noticing that the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our cornerstone (its groundbreaking in September 1963) is coming up. Maybe an event could be planned for September, present a Pastor Emeritus.

**Housekeeping Items:** Playground equipment/lawn ornaments – Joyce contacted John Onkka, Pastor Onkka's son. He is no longer actively sculpting. A suggestion was made- something that would be up year-round, a bench with a plaque or one that kids could sit on or climb on, like a sculpture in which they could climb into Jesus' lap. Erin contacted Rainbow in Appleton. They have wooden playground equipment; different levels using different grades of lumbers; one lower grade lumber, medium-heavy lumber, heavy lumber; the lower the lumber grade, the younger their recommendation for kids that would be using it. She asked for a price range but has not received it yet. A Noah's Ark type was also suggested; they seem to be expensive if the company does its building, but the plans can be purchased for very cheap if we build it. Stacy mentioned another place that deals with metal equipment, but nobody has checked into the details yet. Pastor looked at the village park equipment, noting that it is very nice, but might be too big to our place, and wondered about whether anybody would come to our equipment with that so close by.

**Old Business:** Advertising policy- The subject of advertising within the church premises came to the forefront because some subtle business advertising has been noted. It was thought that, maybe before it gets out of hand (i.e. to prevent pop-ups on our web site and Facebook, little brochures being left, etc.) we should have an official advertising policy; as in we don't allow any except in the interest of FLC unless pre-approved by the church. Council agreed unanimously. A motion was made, and a policy created, regarding advertising on the church premises, that it be allowed only in the interest of FLC unless pre-approved by the church. Motion Carries.

**New Business:** Thrivent Money- Thrivent always gives a percentage of income in charitable donations; several members have chosen Faith for their Thrivent Choice funds (comes in quarterly); In 2022 it went to youth gathering and camp scholarships. This year the Council has decided to give it to our camp fund. Motion was made and carried that 2023 Thrivent Choice funds received be put into our camp fund. Hands on Mission Committee – No missions lately; Some of the money left was used for Soup for the Souls; there is still \$48 in that account. Request for \$400.00 (annual request) for Bell Choir account –The Board of Lay Ministry made its annual request for maintenance on bells, so there would be money for needed repairs when that comes up. Motion was made and carried to move \$400 from the undesignated memorial fund to the bell choir fund for repairs.

**Lay Ministry:** Pine Haven's Men's Chorus will be here February 12<sup>th</sup>.

**Property:** They received a letter from WPS on billing; new budget billing will be starting. They have been discussing the problem of where to store the lawnmower- it cannot stay where it is since the hydrant is right there and the fire department won't get decent access to water should they need to.

**Christian Education:** 9th grade Confirmation classes continue to go well. Larry is very much enjoying his leading/teaching of the students. Sunday school has resumed from the holiday break. Bridget Valleskey has volunteered to lead the month of January. Planning dates for Vacation Bible School, either the week of 6/19-6/23 or 6/26-6/30.

**Youth and Family Ministry:** They are planning a sledding outing in 2 weeks.

**Adjourn:** Having completed all business, a motion was made, and the meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer at 8:46 pm. Next meeting February 20, 2023 at 6:30.

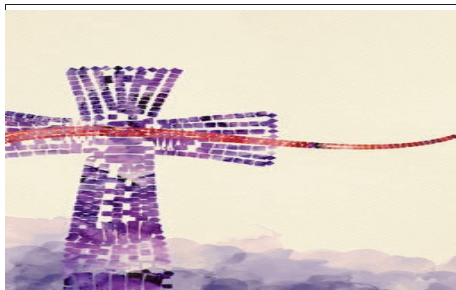

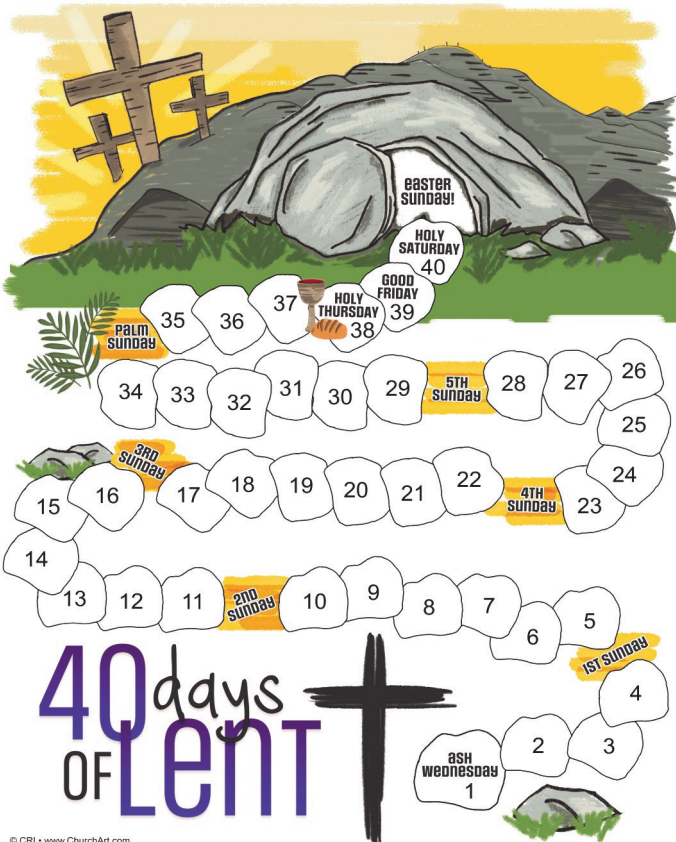
