# **Count Your Blessings**

I believe it is very important to pause to count our blessings, and to give God *thanks* for those blessings. That is the true purpose of Thanksgiving as a national holiday. That is what turns it into a *holy* day, not just a day off.

In 1863, Lincoln set Thanksgiving as an official holiday to be celebrated the fourth Thursday of November every year. He did it in the midst of the Civil War, calling on people to recognize the many blessings God continued to bestow on them and to pray for the healing of the nation. 2020 has been a turbulent year and we need more than most years to pause, count our blessings, give thanks, and pray for our healing of our nation.

As a church we should pause and reflect on how God has blessed this congregation. One of the great blessings came through Pastor Bob Onkka who passed October 9<sup>th</sup> at the age of 98. He brought the three churches together, Valders LC, Our Savior's LC, and Gjerpen LC, which were merged into one congregation, Faith Lutheran Church and in 1963 our beautiful building was finished and dedicated. I have heard many stories from our older members about Pastor Onkka's ministry here that touched and changed lives for the Lord. *Count your blessings and give thanks!* 

Paul wrote to the Philippians from prison, "I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now... It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and, whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me."

Paul was focused on his blessings, not just his present circumstances, being in prison because of his faith. It was with a heart of thanksgiving that he wrote, and with *joy*. I'll bet Pastor Onkka had that same heart of thanks and joy as he would remember the partnership in the Gospel that he had with you here at Faith Lutheran Church.

May we all count our blessings this Thanksgiving season and always. I certainly give thanks for the partnership we have in the gospel. It brings me joy as we serve the Lord together.


Do you like to decorate? Do you need an extra boost to get in the Holiday Spirit? Or maybe you just enjoy the beauty of the church at Christmas time.

# The Rev. Anne Edison-Albright Elected Bishop of the East Central Synod of Wisconsin

On September 26th the East Central Synod of Wisconsin gathered virtually for the 2020 Synod Assembly. The Rev. Anne Edison-Albright was elected Bishop of the synod on the 5th ballot with a total of 151 votes. The entirety of the synod assembly proceeding along with the complete results of the election for Bishop can be found on the synods website at www.ecsw.org

Bishop-Elect Anne Edison-Albright currently serves as the Director of College Ministries and College Pastor at Luther College in Decorah, IA. She has served the Luther College community since 2016. She previously served as pastor at Redeemer Lutheran Church in Stevens Point, WI, her first call, from 2010-2016. Her pastoral ministry in both Wisconsin and Iowa have been marked by passion

for ecumenical and interfaith collaboration; community organizing; faith formation for all ages;

collegiality and joy in bringing congregations together; and encouraging and equipping lay and rostered leaders.

The Rev. Edison-Albright has also served as a hospital chaplain, a pastoral intern at the international congregation in Bratislava, Slovakia, and a summer missionary/English teacher in Chu Zhou, China. Before becoming a pastor Anne was a high school English and English as a Second Language teacher in Houston, TX. Anne received Bachelor of Arts degrees in English and journalism from Michigan State University in East Lansing, MI (2003) and an MDiv from Yale Divinity School in New Haven, CT (2008). She's married to Sean Edison-Albright and mom to Walter and Sally. She enjoys gardening, baking, embroidery and listening to podcasts to refresh and renew her. Following her election as bishop she stated, "Coming back to the East Central Synod of Wisconsin feels like coming home, and I am looking forward to reconnecting and also getting to know the synod in a very new way. I am honored and grateful for the opportunity to serve alongside you as bishop; to encourage and equip you as leaders and to be part of the good and vital work you are doing every day. I am deeply thankful for the ministry and leadership of Bishop Mansholt, and pray for transition blessings for him and Anita and the whole family. I ask for prayers for me, Sean, Walter and Sally, too!"

The Faithful Quilters will be displaying some of the 485 quilts they made throughout the year. These quilts will be displayed on the pews during the month of November.

This has been a difficult year as quilts were not shipped because of the closing of the distribution center with lack of volunteers due to Covid-19. Many of these quilts are already boxed and ready for shipping next October 2021.

In the meantime, the women decided to continue quilting but making these quilts warmer and distributing them locally to Faith's Pantry as well as the Salvation Army, The Crossing, Hope House, The Haven and InCourage. To make them warmer, we will need YOUR help in donating clean mattress pads, clean sheets, blankets, fabric, or monetary gifts so we can purchase bolts of batting or fabric. (checks can be made to Faith Lutheran Church Quilter Fund or place money in envelope found in the pew mark it Faithful Quilters and place in the offertory box.in the back of church. This fall we did not meet each Thursday due to the Covid scare. Women continued to make quilt tops and masks at home. A special quilt was made for Dorothy Ulness in celebration of her 100th birthday. We were able to mail 125 masks to Lutheran World Relief, another 50 were given to local schools and churches. Thank you Hands On Mission for covering the postage as well as the Thrivent Action Team gift card for replenishing supplies.

# Pastor's Report

Topics discussed from his handout: Visits to homes and hospitals. 3 Funerals this past month. Meetings: Interim Pastor meeting, boards, synod meeting.

### \*OLD BUSINESS\*

- \* Hiring of Youth Coordinator: We have recommendation from the Personnel Committee to hire Stacy Schwoerer in Youth Coordinator position; 20 hours/week, paid hourly, @ \$14.00/hr; with the requirement of completion of on-line courses: Youth and Family Ministry Certification Training. Introduce her to congregation and install her on Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup>. Motion made and carried to hire Stacy Schwoerer in Youth Coordinator position as of October 1, 2020.
- \* Joining of Youth and Family and Christian Ed committee meetings. Discussion was a follow up from last meeting.. Boards themselves are not being combined; but sometimes will *meet* together. This is being tried.

#### \*NEW BUSINESS\*

Follow up on new windows for offices (Christine's & Pastor's). Bill reported from Mark that 2 contractors are coming to take a look. One already says they are swamped, and it will take a while to get the work done.

# \*Council Representative Reports\*

### **Stewardship** – Stephanie Mittnacht

We are sending out Stewardship letters this week. Letter basically reviews goals set last year; they have been accomplished. Also, to say thank you for continuing help. The goal for next year is to pay down our Capital Debt with the forethought that it would be preferable to have it finished and non-existent when a new pastor is called.

### Lay Ministry – Joyce Sorenson

Planning for upcoming holiday schedule is being discussed, though decisions are not easy due to considerations of Covid-19 precautions. BOLM is open for suggestions. Discussion about Christmas Eve service options. Attendance at 3:00 service is largest, nearly 300+ without social distancing; with distancing 100-125. There will be no communion, as it would be too difficult. We'll add a service.

#### **Evangelism** – Julie Endries

A suggestion was made that maybe Faith could "adopt" someone (we become the senior center) from church, do something with them (like make a meal, cookies...play cards...) show them care, concern.

### Fellowship - Cheryl Domrath

They made chicken rice soup during Gods work our hands. From the Quilters: LWR not accepting those on the stage. Christian quilts not wanted, so it is their idea to give them to the Salvation Army; the Crossing, a pregnancy care center; our parishioners in nursing homes; The quilts would be given out with a label saying "Made for you by quilters from Faith Lutheran Church". It would be a positive outreach to these people. This idea was received positively by the Council members.

## **Youth and Family Ministry** – *Bobby Jo Robley*

Joint Meetings with Board of Christian Ed. This is being tried.. Will plan on a joint September meeting. Discussions regarding events for the upcoming holiday season: Walk through Bethlehem- will be done but with social distancing. Pumpkin Patch- held outdoors, so okay to do this. Possible Lefse making?
