

HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS: Bill reported that the laptop has been purchased and necessary software installed. Warranty was upgraded from 2 years to 4 years. The laptop has been passed on to Judy. The portable sound system is here and able to be used. The headphones and jumper cable for the sound system are here and installed. There are still some issues to work out. Bill is hoping to disable the mute button on the laptop as the live stream went out without sound again. The Call Committee was conducting an interview of the last remaining candidate this evening. A motion was made and carried to give the Call Committee direction to explore all avenues to find a Pastoral candidate. Significant conversation took place regarding the wording in the proposed Wedding Policy/Guideline document. Julie Endries will rework the document and present it at the August council meeting.

OLD BUSINESS: Discussion continued about eliminating the permanent YouTube link of each worship service.

NEW BUSINESS: Premises Security: Bill highlighted security concerns area churches are experiencing and stressed a need for Faith to investigate and improve our security. Suggestions included training head ushers, completing a premise security checklist, increasing times doors are locked, and installing cameras. Motion was made & carried to allow Bill to investigate ways to improve church security.
