

1 Council voted in December 2022 to set aside \$100,000 of Faith's checking account balance to fund the Youth Coordinator position. There is \$45,273.96 remaining of these funds.

Although the Youth Coordinator salary is included in current year expenses, which affects Net Income/Net Loss, it is not paid with current year income.

New Business

Preliminary budget projection- Income projected: overall, less money is projected to come in but expenses have gone up. Net loss *projected* is \$90,000 which is worse than projected last year. It won't be quite that in reality because we do have some left from the amount projected last year, but caution is advised since it appears we are spending more than we're taking in. Budget needs to be finished and put forth at the December meeting. It will need to be brought to congregation for approval at our annual Congregational meeting. That meeting will take place on January 19th with January 26th set in the event we need a snow-day.

Lions Club Nativity Scene: It's been brought to our attention that the Nativity Scene cannot be put where it always has been. The new property owner doesn't wish it to be there. It will be put it on the corner of our property instead. A motion was made and carried to move the nativity scene to the corner of the church property.

Lay Ministry – Jennifer Ott

The board says thank-you to Bill and Sue for the videos and pictures of the Veteran's Day Video. Thanksgiving Service will be on Tuesday, November 26th, with communion. No Wednesday service that week. Advent starts December 1st with a liturgy change and a sing-along before each service. Volunteers are needed to lead these. The wreath will be placed on December 1st. Decorating is to be done on December 7th. Christmas Eve services with communion will be at 3:00 pm, 5:00 pm, and 10:00 pm. Christmas Day service will be at 9:00 a.m. No communion at that service. A service of lessons and carols will be held on December 29th.

Stewardship – Joan Pritzl

She met with Jill; they've been discussing changes in line items of the financial statement to attempt a clarification, so items are more correlated with in and out, and clear of purpose. They also want to add a line for miscellaneous items. Joan needs an expected estimate of what can be allowed for blinds. She will need to know the desired color and type of blinds, as well as measurements needed for them so she can figure out what buy. She will be talking to the quilters about this, too.

Evangelism – Julie Hartman

Warming shelter project. We discussed the Church's contribution to the fund. A motion was made and carried to create a line item change to the budget to take ½% LWR and ½% from World Hunger and redirect that money to local giving; Haven, Hope House, the Warming Shelter.

Fellowship – Marilyn Robley

Things are moving along normally. Kudos were given to Fellowship from the Council for the services they provide after worship services.

Property – *Mark Zutz*

Windows are done. Insurance increase has been figured into their budget; the amount for snow removal was low-ered; not a lot of changes overall for next year; maintenance is included.

Christian Education - Alisa Madson (May be reported by Larry &/or Bridget)

Inasmuch collection- Faith on Fire will make the delivery after the service on Wednesday night, December 4th. They need cookie donations for the cookie walk. The kids will have donut holes and chocolate milk after the program on December 15th.

Youth and Family Ministry – Gretchen Spindler

They made lefse, 100 dozen, on Friday. Kudos go to Mike and Erin Lenzner for their preparation and help.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:56 pm. Meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.
