#### Vacation Bible School Begins!

Spring is now springing as I write this article. The last frost is just behind us, but a couple of weeks after you receive this newsletter, high summer will be here in the form of Vacation Bible School. The theme this year is the story of Joseph (and his coat of many colors) and his time in Egypt: "From Prison to Palace." We will learn about God's guidance, forgiveness, and faithfulness. And we will all have fun doing crafts, playing games, watching silly adults do silly skits, and, most of all, learning songs and learning the hand gestures to the songs. Of course we will have snacks also every day.

I have not looked ahead at the Egyptian-themed snacks, but I bet there is something pyramid-shaped and something wrapped like a mummy. They just seem like natural products of the theme.

We usually think of VBS as being for children, and it certainly is, but we often have an equal amount of teachers and teacher's helpers. For a group of 40 kids we will have 25 adults and 15 teens helping. And that is a lot of people! Why do so many people help? Because it is a lot of fun, and we can do a lot of good in the 4 days of VBS instruction and the Friday of celebration.

There are lots of people who have never gone to church. Their parents just never took them. They watched TV instead, or slept in on Sundays. But I have talked to many people who say that they DID go to Vacation Bible School. They know about Jesus from VBS. They know some hymns from VBS. They know the Bible stories from VBS. Why was I talking to them if they were not coming to my church? Because they had things come up later in their life that called for spiritual resources, and VBS had been a spiritual treasure in their lives, so they came looking for more treasure.

You can be a part of it, June 16-19, and at the family event June 20. Sign up your kids. Come volunteer!

Our Anniversary

We have started to celebrate our 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. First Lutheran, our sibling church born on the same day that we were in 1850, has held an Organ Recital and reception at First Lutheran. We are holding our first event on June 15<sup>th</sup> (Father's Day), during 9AM worship here at Faith.

It just so happened that the Thompson family reunion was being held during the Father's Day weekend and several members of the Thompson family are ELCA pastors. A family member suggested that one of them preach to

celebrate the family roots here at Faith. Conrad Thompson was particularly notable as a son of Faith Lutheran Church who went on to significant work in the national and international church. He was head of evangelism for the American Lutheran Church (the whole ALC denomination), and later the director of the radio show, "Lutheran Vespers," where he was also a frequent and popular speaker.

As I shared about the 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, they told me that Conrad Thompson's final sermon was for the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary here at Faith. So it seems entirely appropriate that his son, the Pastor Mervin Thompson be the preacher for the 175<sup>th</sup>. I hope that in 25 years we can get another Thompson to preach for the 200<sup>th</sup>!

In other news about our anniversary, I have started to receive recipes for our commemorative cookbook. Of course we would like to have any historic old-timey recipes. How you boil down your maple syrup perhaps, or your family's lefse recipe. But then we also want just good recipes to make tasty food. The sort of recipes future generations will prepare and say, "Dang! Our ancestors were good cooks!"

And we will put a copy of the cookbook in the time capsule we are preparing. The plan is to seal up the time capsule at the end of this year and open it in 25 years, for our bicentennial. And all the people in the photographs will be 25 years older. The baby I just baptized will be all grown up. The confirmation kids will be married with kids. They will marvel at the photos of the parking lot full of gas automobiles that just roll on tires instead of flying on antigravity panels. In the pictures of the congregation there will be no robot servants ready to fetch you a donut at the fellowship hour. We will say, "Ah things were so different in the old days!"

Start thinking about your message to the future that you would like to put in the time capsule. Select a few good recipes and bring them in. And plan to come to worship on June 15<sup>th</sup>.

#### Housekeeping Item

It was reported that the dishwasher was fixed.

#### Old Business

Video streaming issues: Bill reported that we have new LED lights that are brighter so he will be monitoring to see how that affects the video quality of the livestream. Cameras are old and they don't close as they should so we are getting overexposure. We are getting to the point of having to do something with the cameras, due to their age. May do it in stages so we don't have one big expense at one time. As this is done, they will remove old wiring that has been left in place. We will work on adjusting what we have now to start. Bill has been working with Northern Lights, which is doing a great job. Currently have four cameras, including one showing the projection screen at all times. The wiring is in but new security cameras are not in yet.

Synod Assembly: We still need one more person to attend synod assembly: Bridget agreed to attend. Logo wear items: Julie said the logo items will be available soon with 18 options and two logos to choose from. Orders will be by internet and Larry and Julie will help pick up orders. Church does not handle money with this ordering system.

AED update: Bridget contacted Heart-a-Rama and they will get back to her after the May fundraiser. They have put Faith on the list to get an AED if they raise enough money.

A short update was given about the 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary at First Lutheran that Faith has been asked to be a part of.

#### **New Business**

The council wants to thank the brass choir for the music at Easter.

#### Council representative reports:

**Treasurer's Report:** Bob presented his printed report. Donations are up over last year at this time.

Lay Ministry: Jennifer: One more person is needed to help with livestreaming as one currently on the list will be leaving for college in the fall. There has been positive feedback on the improvements in the projection screen display at worship services. Thanks to Christine for her work on this each week. Two Ash Wednesday services will be held again next year. Attendance this year was 29 at the early and 55 at the late service and 202 were at the Palm Sunday service. The Holden liturgy was well received and it may be used again for Advent and occasional Sundays. Some people have requested more contemporary songs in weekly worship services and Pastor Dan will try to work some into his planning. Also, plans are being made for a video for Memorial Day and the Baccalaureate service for Valders graduates on June 1

Evangelism: Julie: The committee discussed the Valders parade on August 7 and considered projects for God's Work, Our Hands Day on September 7.

Fellowship: Marilyn: A big thanks to everyone who helped with the Lenten soup and sandwich nights and the Easter breakfast, both of which showed awesome fellowship. The committee also thanks the anonymous donor who helped pay for a new coffee pot. Marilyn concluded with a thought as the NFL draft was approaching in Green Bay: "Jesus is choosing us to be his disciples."

Church Properties: Loren: The organ is having an issue with vibration and will be looked at. He asked for details about the concrete pad needed for the Onkka bench, but the information was not yet available. Loren also noted that he attempted to clean the mildew off the exterior wall of the church, but chlorine didn't work and he will try another solution.

Christian Education: Bridget: Chase Wilker and another person from Crossways Camps taught Sunday school children some songs and will be here again when the children sing on Mother's Day. She said a cake has been ordered for Confirmation Sunday on May 18. The registration table is set up for Vacation Bible School and they are looking for more volunteers for VBS.

Youth & Family Ministry: The Easter Breakfast went well.


