I was with some church people and we were eating, as gatherings of church people often do. We offered prayer before dining and then, when the dessert came out, I joked that I felt like praying again because the sight of the delicious desserts had inspired new gratitude in me. When you feel grateful, it is important to express that gratitude. Sometimes we thank people. Other times, especially for more general circumstances, we thank God. When the harvest is plentiful or the family is healthy, or we have gathered with people we love, we thank God.

We are in the Thanksgiving season. I like Thanksgiving as a holiday. Thanksgiving does not have the gift-giving stresses of Christmas. Halloween has gotten to be a big holiday, but it has a less joyous character. Thanksgiving is a gem between the two. Thanksgiving has good food and plenty of it. Usually family has gathered and I like our family pretty well. Nobody has a feud or anything. In the old days the turkey white meat always came out dry, but grandma made plenty of good gravy so we were all happy. Now I am grateful for all the ways we have figured out how to keep it from drying out: frying it, smoking it, brining it. Grandma would get a huge turkey, but she would almost always worry that it would not be enough, so an unexpected ham would come out of the kitchen too. Happy memories.

As a pastor, I often participated in the community Thanksgiving Eve service. Thanksgiving is not an exclusively Christian holiday, just as thankfulness is not an exclusively Christian emotion. So every group in our small college town would come and share prayer and readings. The Muslims, the Jews, the Buddhists, the Roman Catholics, would get together with all the Protestants and share the readings and prayers of their traditions about giving thanks. It was beautiful.

May we all share our treasured traditions and thankful hearts in this blessed season.

### Faith Lutheran Church Minutes—September 18, 2023

**Pastor's Report:** Peggy Madson's funeral – also visited her son Andrew. Made hospital and communion visits. Baptism for Kinsley Wittmus and met to plan 2 additional baptisms. Salm/Hoeppner wedding. Senior Appreciation lunch. Attended several board meetings. Installation event – Pastor shared he was deeply moved and thankful for the efforts made. Visioning event will be held in the Gathering Space following service on October 1<sup>st</sup>. Pizza will be served following the event.

Old Business ~ Installation Expense: A motion was made and carried that installation expenses, not covered by the Thrivent gift card, be paid out of Undesignated Memorial funds. Financial Policy Guidelines ~ The Stewardship Committee met with Christine and Jill to discuss concerns regarding the new Financial Policies. It was decided that a few of the items needed to be reworded or changed. Don handed out the financial policy as updated and a form available in the office to request reimbursement or approve expenses. Changes made from original approved financial statements. Bookkeeper will still be signing checks. Bookkeeper will complete reconciliation & provide a report to Treasurer. Board chairpersons need to approve bills before going to Jill for recording and payment. Council members should review the updated Financial Statements/Guidelines in preparation for a vote at next Council meeting. Comment – bills & expenses needing approval must include sufficient detail, including item(s) description, purpose, and item(s) cost. Church Directory: Photoshoot dates will be November 29<sup>th</sup> -December 2<sup>nd</sup>, which received 8 votes out of 12. Contract was signed by Joan Pritzl following Council approval. We need to decide if we will allow members to have pictures taken with their pets and if we do, if pictures with pets may be put in the directory.

**New Business:** Organist position: We need to advertise to fill our open organist position - ideas of where to advertise were discussed. Piano players may also be considered. Bridget Valleskey requested a credit card to cover Sunday School or youth event expenses, so she does not need to pay for them with personal funds. Motion made and carried to provide Bridget with a credit card with a credit limit of \$1,000. Quilters would like to hold a silent auction of several quilts from November 5<sup>th</sup> through November 19<sup>th</sup>. Motion made and carried to hold a silent auction in November to raise funds for quilting supplies.

<u>Lay Ministry</u> - Opportunity Day – October 15<sup>th</sup> in Gathering Space – A representative from each of Faith's volunteer positions/boards will be available to answer questions and explain what they do. Each board should have a volunteer present to talk about their activities

<u>Evangelism</u> – God's Work Our Hands went well. Christmas Wreath will be put up on outside of church again this Advent/Christmas season.

<u>Christian Education</u> – Alisa Madson has agreed to serve as Director for the Board of Christian Education. Sunday School had 45 students attend the first week. Rally Sunday Bible distribution - 18 Bibles were given out to 4K, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, & 7<sup>th</sup> grade students. Communion Retreat – October 8<sup>th</sup>. First Communion Sunday – October 15<sup>th</sup> – cake will be served following the service. Motion made & carried to approve Alisa Madson as the new Director of the Board of Christian Education.

<u>Stewardship</u> – Budgets should be submitted by the October Council meeting. Erin reported that Faith received \$2,000 from the estate of Pastor Robert Esse, a son of this congregation.

<u>Property</u> – Working on gathering estimates for parking lot. Replace Fellowship Hall carpeting with carpet tiles – 1<sup>st</sup> estimate was \$28,000. Kitchen floor replacement estimate-\$5,500. Window replacements for some rooms also.

<u>Fellowship</u> – Pastor Dan's Installation – served 109. Potluck brunch on 5<sup>th</sup> Sundays will be served in the Gathering Space – first one will be October 29<sup>th</sup>

Youth and Family Ministry – 14 people attended highway cleanup.
