The following week, in worship September 17th, is the beginning of Sunday School, with Bibles given out and backpacks blessed.



Join us for a Health Fair on October 14. Everyone is invited to attend.

Valders Ambulance/Fire Department Paramedics will be present to offer training on the following:

- 1. Learn the difference between a heart attack and stroke along with symptoms, etc.
- 2. What to do when someone is experiencing symptoms of a heart attack or stroke.
- 3. What is CPR and when is it indicated.
- 4. Demonstration of CPR and practice time if warranted.
- 5. What is an AED? When is it needed? Where is it found at Faith Lutheran?
- 6. What info is needed when calling 911?
- 7. Is there any information that is helpful for ambulance personnel when they arrive?

Discussion on: Oxygen usage, blood pressure cuff and stethoscope and where is found at Faith.


Blood pressures will be taken in the community room following training.

Faith Lutheran Church Minutes—July 17, 2023

Pastor Dan: Purchased Crossways Bible Study, which has a cost for participants. Tuesday afternoon seems to be a good time, with the time determined by preference indicated by those who sign up. Holy Conversations – Informational booklet from our Synod regarding planning for the future. The ELCA is one half the size it was 40 years ago when the merger occurred to form the ELCA. Other denominations may have had an even larger decline. The largest religious group in America are those called the "nones" that have no religious affiliation. The Holy Conversations include discernment of real current situation of congregation and options available, including transformation, partnership, intentional vitality process, sale of building, lay leadership, shared ministry, merger. Pastor Dan indicated that Faith Lutheran is in good shape, compared to other congregations. He is happy to be performing baptisms and weddings, which indicate a future for this congregation. Faith has deep roots, which will help it survive in today's world. Pastor Dan reviewed the document, asking some of the questions of the Council. Conversations would begin with Council & then go to the congregation. Sue Riesterer gave a temple talk regarding taking piano & guitar lessons at Faith for members of our community. So far, we do not have the 4 people interested in lessons required to make this possible.

Old Business: The rubber mulch was installed & cost less than thought \$2,385 + edging & landscaping (\$450.70.) Shed fund has \$5,306 & the slab has been poured.

New Business: Church Directory donation – A member of the congregation has provided a donation towards a new Church Directory. Julie Hartman reported on her research to find a church pictorial directory provider. Harmann Studios – Traditional directory service that provides photography services. No cost for directory since cost is covered by the members who order pictures. Color Craft (LifeWay) – Uses photos submitted by members and charges \$25 + shipping per directory. Will also take photos for additional charge & provides an active mobile online directory. Joan Pritzl offered to further research directory providers and oversee the project.

Financial Policy Guidelines: Stewardship Committee reviewed the guidelines. Since we now have a Treasurer position, guidelines needed to be reviewed to determine what duties would be completed by the Treasurer, council may review what was provided and give suggestions or thoughts. A finalized copy will be up for discussion at the August Council meeting.

Youth Group plans: High School students (10, 11, 12th grade). Redecorating the Youth Room. Will include a Bible Study in their meetings. The youth in this group have come up with ideas & will be choosing a new name soon.

Fund Raisers: Confusion was expressed as to which account is currently receiving the profit from the Easter Breakfast and Lefse. Is it going to the Luther League or some other youth account? Stephanie explained that funds in the Luther League account are for post confirmed student activities & the Youth & Family account is for pre-confirmation youth activities. NYG is next year in July. There may be an opportunity for youth from Faith to travel on a bus with other local congregations.

Stewardship – In August we will start planning the stewardship drive for this fall.

Evangelism – Taking part in the parade with the theme "Fishing for People" for 60 years – Pastor Dan's truck towing a boat with people in the boat "pretending" to fish for people. God's Work. Our Hands. is being planned.

Lay Ministry - Quartet from Pine Haven will be here.

Fellowship – September 6 will be the Senior Appreciation Luncheon for those 75 years and over, staff, quilters, and past pastors & interims will be invited.

Property – Concrete pad was poured for the shed. Braun Building Center has given a reduction in the price.

Christian Education – Larry and Bridget. Two people have stepped forward to teach Sunday school and 2 to 4 more are needed. Need to determine spaces for the classrooms. Bridget reported on the 2023/24 curriculum that has been chosen. Requested replacement of the chalkboards with whiteboards. Memorization of catechism sections will be included in the curriculum. It was requested that the Youth Report be prepared in written form & turned into Christine & copies sent out to Council. Confirmation classes will be held during Lent in 2024.

Youth and Family Ministry – Mini-golf and ice cream social is being planned.




